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Nominations are being accepted for the annual CAI-NE chapter awards recognizing community associations, volunteer leaders and industry professionals around New England. **Submission deadline is January 31, 2017.**

Awards will be presented at the annual CAI-NE chapter banquet on Friday, March 24, 2017 at the Marriott Hotel in Burlington, MA. Award recipients will receive a complimentary banquet ticket and their stories published in Condo Media magazine.

ASSOCIATION ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

- COMMUNITY PROGRAMS & EVENTS:** A program or event that brings residents together and fosters community spirit and inclusiveness.
From barbecues and yard sales to tournaments and tours, associations around New England are providing more opportunities to engage residents and build community. Nominate your community for a program that brings together residents.
- LANDSCAPE/BUILDING BEAUTIFICATION:** Landscape or building improvements that boost or enhance the community's curb appeal.
Budgets of all sizes can make a difference from planting a new bed of flowers or updating curbside mail stations to adding entrance awnings or landscape features like stone walls or pond fountains. Nominations should include photos (before and after if possible) and a description of the improvement project.
- MEMBER COMMUNICATIONS:** An effective communication tool that informs residents/owners on a regular and ongoing basis about community events as well as association business, volunteer governance and resident/owner responsibilities.
From email and simple newsletters to more sophisticated websites and social networking sites communities of all sizes are finding ways to get the message out. Share the effective way your community is keeping all residents informed and include a description as well as a sample communication in the nomination.
- CREATIVE SOLUTIONS:** Recognizing an association for the unique way in which it has improved the community or solved a problem.
From green practices and sustainable building solutions to recruiting volunteers and motivating residents, associations around New England are addressing new challenges and improving communities in both big ways and small. This award will showcase a community that has addressed a common situation in a not so common way.
- COMMUNITY OF THE YEAR:** An association that has overcome a devastating event or obstacle necessitating excellence in board governance/management, financial oversight and/or resident involvement.
Bad things happen to good communities. Disasters including floods, fires and wind as well as mismanagement, fraud and embezzlement can cripple a community, but how management, boards and residents respond makes all the difference in getting the community back on track. This award will spotlight a community and everyone involved in its recovery and/or rebuilding.

INDIVIDUAL/COMPANY AWARDS

- COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR**
Recognizing a volunteer who seeks out opportunities to improve their association/community. *Nominees in this category may include owners/residents, association committee members or board members.*
- COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION MANAGER OF THE YEAR**
Recognizing an association manager whose efforts further the goals and objective of their client associations.
- CAI BUSINESS PARTNER OF THE YEAR**
Recognizing an industry professional who has provided exemplary service to an association.
- MANAGEMENT COMPANY OF THE YEAR**
A management company showing dedication to the industry, clients and CAI as well as exhibiting excellence in customer service, management, governance and finance.
